

The Commuter 251 Dial-a-Ride is a weekday transportation service from the Los Ranchos/Journal Center Rail Runner Station to Century Rio 24, the Northwest Transit Center, Intel, Walmart and points in Rio Rancho, and back. This service can accommodate the general public, including seniors and people with disabilities.

- Requests are accepted between 6 a.m. and 12 Noon one business day in advance
- For Monday rides, requests must be made by 12 Noon on the Friday before.

No eligibility requirements.

Rio Metro manages the New Mexico Rail Runner Express commuter rail and operates and/or funds select bus routes in the three-county area. 
